JESUS LOOKS FOR THE LOST

You may have heard of the guy we learned about today before: Zacchaeus. A short guy, no one liked, who climbed a tree trying to see Jesus. Yes, that guy. But Jesus saw a lot more in Zacchaeus than that. He saw a man who was lost. And not in the literal sense, but in His heart. He was busy stealing from people and living selfishly because He didn't know Jesus. Knowing Jesus is when we are truly found and our lives are changed forever.

Today is about getting into action. Did you think of someone you know who might not know Jesus? Good. Now, start praying for them together as a family. Think about how you can invite them to church or share what you are learning with them this week!
