Role Description

Position Summary: Lead the way in creating compelling worship services for Student Ministries. Cultivate a culture of worship at 3Crosses through helping plan, develop, execute and lead worship services and any other events or programs where the Worship Ministry is active in the life of the church.

The Student Ministries Worship Coordinator is an active member of the Student Ministries team through leading Student Ministries in worship. The Students Ministries Coordinator meets regularly with the Worship Director/Pastor of the church. They will be responsible for raising up Student Ministries worship volunteers and musicians.

Key Areas of Responsibility and Oversight

- Work with pastors of middle school, high school, college, and young adults to plan and execute worship for midweek and Sunday gatherings.
- Develop teams of worship team volunteers, including their musical and spiritual development.
- Meet with and support the Worship Director/Pastor regularly.
- Lead three worship services per week (20/20, Omega, Praxis).
- Prepare all worship production needs: Ableton Tracks, Pro Presenter, stage setup/teardown.
- Support ministry pastors with special projects as needed.
- Assist Sunday Team in leading worship several times per month.
- Collaborate with the Music Director and Sunday Team in preparing song lists and liturgies for Sunday, but in a support capacity rather than a final responsibility.
- All other relevant duties as assigned by uplink.
