START LISTENING TO CD #2.

Jesus Christ has promised to take you to be with Him!

"I will take you to be with me that you may also be where I am." John 14:1-2

For some of us this will be at death.

"To be away from the body and at home with the Lord." 2 Corinthians 5:8

For others this will be at the rapture.

"Brothers, I do not want you to be ignorant about these things." I Thessalonians 4:13



What is the Rapture?

The Rapture is the snatching away of all believers from earth to meet the Lord in the air!

"I will take you to be with me that you may also be where I am."

What is the difference between the Rapture and the 2nd Coming?

1. The Rapture is a private event whereas the 2nd Coming is a public event!

"Look, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him." Revelation 1:7

2. The Rapture is upward (earth to heaven) whereas the 2nd Coming is downward (heaven to earth).

"The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean." Revelation 19:14

3. The Rapture is an imminent event (any-moment, signless) whereas the 2nd Coming is predictive (follows established signs, primarily the Tribulation).

"No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father." Matthew 24:36

"So you also must be ready, because the Son of man will come at an hour you do not expect him." Matthew 24:44

"Behold, I am coming soon!" Revelation 22:12

4. The Rapture is for believers only, whereas the 2nd Coming affects all humanity.

What are the three primary purposes of the Rapture?

1) The Rapture will fulfill Jesus' promise of taking believers to be with him.

"I will take you to be with me that you may also be where I am." John 14:2b

2) The Rapture will spare the church the judgment and horrors of the Tribulation.

"Since you have kept my command to endure patiently, I will also keep you from the hour of trial that is going to come upon the whole world to test those who live on the earth." Revelation 3:10

"For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ." I Thessalonians 5:9

3) The Rapture will complete the church age, and usher in the Tribulation—which God will use to prepare Israel for her restoration!

How is this hitting you so far, that any second you could be raptured because Jesus has promised to take you to be with him forever in heaven?



What are the specifics about the Rapture?

I Thessalonians 4:13-18

1. The Rapture involves a resurrection—For dead believers.

2. The Rapture involves a return—The Lord in the air.

"Men of Galilee, why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven." Acts 1:11

3. The Rapture involves a transformation—For Christians who are still alive.

"But we will be changed—in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed." 1 Corinthians 15:52

"But we know that when he appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is." I John 3:2b

4. The Rapture involves a reunion—Being with the Lord and one another forever!

There is a definite order of sequential reunions:

- \Rightarrow Dead bodies are reunited with their Spirits.
- Resurrected believers are reunited with living Raptured believers.
- Resurrected believers and Raptured believers meet the Lord in the air.



The Rapture

What is the Tribulation?

The Tribulation is a 7 year period of time between the Rapture of the Church and the Second Coming of Christ.

"You are the salt of the earth...You are the light of the world." Matthew 5:13-14

"For the secret power of lawlessness is already at work; but the one who now holds it back will continue to do so t ill he is taken out of the way." 1 Thessalonians 2:7

The Tribulation

"For then there will be great distress, unequaled from the beginning of the world until now—and never to be equaled again. If those days had not been cut short, no one would survive, but for the sake of the elect those days will be shortened." Matthew 24:21-22

Where do we get the teaching that the Tribulation will last for 7 years?

"Daniel's 70th Week" Daniel 9:24-27

"The end will come like a flood: War will continue until the end, and desolations have been decreed. He will confirm a covenant with many for one seven. In the middle of the seven he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on a wing of the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him." Daniel 9:26-27

In the New Testament the 7 Year Tribulation is clearly divided into two periods.

The first half (3 ¹/₂ years) is known at the Tribulation. (*Matthew 24:4-14; Revelation 6, 8, 9*)

The second half (3 ¹/₂ years) is known as The Great Tribulation. (*Matthew* 24:15-28; *Revelation* 16)

Why will there be a Tribulation?

1. Judgment—To put an end to wickedness!

"To put an end to sin...to bring in everlasting righteousness." Daniel 9:24

"You are just in these judgments, you who are and who were, the Holy One, because you have so judged." Revelation 16:5

2. Evangelism--To bring the gospel to every nation!

"And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come." Matthew 24:14

"He is not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance." 2 Peter 3:9

3. Israel—restored to Jesus and prophesies fulfilled!

What will the Tribulation be like for those not Raptured who remain on earth?

Three terrible realities immediately following the Rapture:

- 1. Absolute chaos caused by the Rapture!
- 2. The restraining influence of the Holy Spirit is removed.

"For the secret power of lawlessness is already at work; but the one who now holds it back will continue to do so till he is taken out of the way." 1 Thessalonians 2:7

3. A brief stage-setting period of time.

The judgments of God during the Tribulation

The Seal Judgments

- 1st Seal—White Horse—Cold War. *Revelation 6:1-2*
- 2nd Seal—Red Horse—Open War. *Revelation 6:3-4*
- 3rd Seal—Black Horse—Famine. *Revelation* 6:5-6
- 4th Seal—Pale Horse—Death. *Revelation* 6:7-8
- 5th Seal—Slain Souls—Martyrdom. *Revelation* 6:9-11
- 6th Seal—Lamb's Wrath—Physical Disturbances. *Revelation 6:12-14*

- 1st Trumpet—Hail & Fire—Upon earth. Rev 8:6-7

- 4th Trumpet--Sun, Moon, Stars—Upon heavens. Rev 8:12-13

What will Antichrist's reign be like politically?

1. He will emerge out of the revived Roman (European) Empire.

"In the time of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be destroyed." Daniel 2:44

2. He will begin inconspicuously.

"And I saw a beast coming out of the sea." Revelation 13:1

3. He will gain public attention through diplomatic brilliance.

"I looked and there before me was a white horse! Its rider held a bow, and he was given a crown, and he rode out as a conqueror bent on conquest." Revelation 6:2



4. He will distinguish himself like no other politician ever has.

"He will seize it through intrigue." Daniel 11:21

5. He will stun the world by solving the Middle East crisis!

"He will make a covenant with many for one seven." Daniel 9:27a

"The whole world was astonished and followed the beast." Revelation 13:3

What will Antichrist's Reign be like spiritually?

- 1. Spiritual darkness will reign!
- ⇒ The Holy Spirit will be removed!

"For the secret power of lawlessness is already at work; but the one who now holds it back will continue to do so till he is taken out of the way." 2 Thessalonians 2:7

→ A deluding influence will be added!

2 Thessalonians 2:8-12

→ Flourishing evil will dominate!

Armageddon will be the final and conclusive battle between the forces of good and evil, it will be a vast and decisive conflict.

Armageddon will be the last, the greatest and the bloodiest world war of human history.

Where will Armageddon take place?

⇒ In Israel on the plane of Megiddo or Armageddon.

"I will gather all the nations to Jerusalem to fight against it." Zechariah 14:1-2

The Battle of Armageddon

"On that day, when all the nations of the earth are gathered against her, I will make Jerusalem an immovable rock for all the nations. All who try to move it will injure themselves." Zechariah 12:2-3

"Then they gathered the kings together to the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon." Revelation 16:16

What are the purposes of Armageddon in the plan of God?

1. Judgment upon unrepentant Israel.

2. Judgment upon the nations that have persecuted Israel.

"I will gather all nations and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. There I will enter into judgment against them concerning my inheritance, my people Israel, for they scattered my people among the nations and divided up my land." Joel 3:2

3. Judgment upon all nations that have rejected Jesus.

"They were seared by the intense heat and they cursed the name of God, who had control over these plagues, but they refused to repent and glorify him." Revelation 16:9

"Then they gathered the kings together to the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon." Revelation 16:16

"The rest of them were killed with the sword that came out of the mouth of the rider on the horse, and all the birds gorged themselves on their flesh." Revelation 19:21

The Time of Jacob's Trouble: "How awful that day will be! None will be like it. It will be a time of trouble for Jacob." Jeremiah 30:7



How will the battle of Armageddon unfold?

Six stages of the Battle of Armageddon

1. Satan is cast out of heaven-enraged that his time is short!

Revelation 12:7-12; Revelation 12:13

2. Satan's first attack on Israel--the battle of Gog. *Ezekiel* 38-39

Eight basic facts about the battle of Gog and Armageddon:

(1) In the battle of Gog, Russia and at least five other nations are involved *(Ezekiel 38:2-6).* In the battle of Armageddon, all the nations of the world are involved *(Revelation 16:14).*

(2) In the battle of Gog, the invaders will attack from the north (*Ezekiel 38:6, 15*). In the battle of Armageddon the armies will come from the north, south, east and west (*Revelation 16:12-16*).

(3) In the battle of Gog, the purpose of the armies is to "take plunder" and "take prey" (*Ezekiel 38:12*). In the battle of Armageddon the purpose is to annihilate the Jews and to fight Jesus and His army (*Revelation 19:19*).

(4) In the battle of Gog, Russia will be the leader of the nations attacking *(Ezekiel 38:1-2, 13)*. In the battle of Armageddon, the Antichrist will be the leader *(Revelation 19:19)*.

(5) In the battle of Gog, God defeats the northern invaders with convulsions of the earth, the confusion of the troops, the contagion of diseases, and calamities from the sky *(Ezekiel 38:19-23)*. In the battle of Armageddon, the armies are defeated by the word of Christ *(Revelation 19:15, 21)*.

The Battle of Armageddon

(6) In the battle of Gog, Israel's enemies will perish on the mountains of Israel and in the open fields (*Ezekiel 39:4-5*). In the battle of Armageddon, those slain by the Lord will lie where they fall, from one end of the earth to the other (*Revelation 19:18; Jeremiah 25:33*).

(7) In the battle of Gog, the dead will be buried (*Ezekiel 39:12-15*). In the battle of Armageddon, the dead will not be buried, their carcasses will be totally consumed by the birds (*Revelation 19:17-18, 21*).

(8) In the battle of Gog, war will continue among the nations involved during the remainder of the Tribulation (*Revelation 13:4-7*) After the battle of Armageddon, swords and spears will be beaten into plow-shares and pruning hooks and nations will study war no more (*Isaiah 2:4*).

3. Satan's next scheme—a massive persecution of the Jews.

"He will confirm a covenant with many for one seven. In the middle of the seven he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on a wing of the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him." Daniel 9:27

"Don't let anyone deceive you in any way, for that day will not come until the rebellion occurs and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the man doomed to destruction. He will oppose and will exalt himself over everything that is called God or is worshiped, so that he sets himself up in God's temple, proclaiming himself to be God." 2 Thessalonians 2:3-4

Luke 21:20-24

4. God counters with the miraculous protection of the Jewish Remnant!

Revelation 12:5-6, 13-17

"Let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains." Matthew 24:16



"I will surely gather all of you, O Jacob; I will surely bring together the remnant of Israel." Micah 2:12 "And so all Israel will be saved." Romans 11:26

5. Armies of the world rebel against the Antichrist.

"The sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from the sky, and the heavenly bodies will be shaken." Matthew 24:29

3. Heaven will open and Christ will appear on a white horse.

"I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and true." Revelation 19:11

4. Jesus will be seen by everyone!

"Look, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him." Revelation 1:7

5. Christ will be followed by the armies of heaven.

"The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean." Revelation 19:14

6. Christ will come in power and great glory.

"This third I will bring into the fire; I will refine them like silver and test them like gold. They will call on my name and I will answer them; I will say they are my people and they will say, the Lord is our God." Zechariah 13:9

"I will gather all the nations to Jerusalem to fight against it; the city will be captured, the houses ransacked, and the women raped. Then the Lord will go out and fight against those nations, as he fights in the day of battle...The Lord will be king over the whole earth. On that day there will be one Lord, and his name the only name." Zech. 14:2, 3, 9

- What will this be like?

How could a loving God send people to hell?



→ Misconception #1 God does not "send" people to hell.

"There are only two kinds of people in the end: Those who say to God, 'Thy will be done.' And those to whom God says, in the end, "Thy will be done." C.S. Lewis

⇒ Misconception #2 God does not send "people" to hell.

"I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again." John 3:3

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son." John 3:16-18

"I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed from death to life." John 5:24

"I don't respect people who <u>don't</u> proselytize, who believe there is a hell and people could be going to hell and you think, well it's not really worth telling them this because it would make it socially awkward...How much do you have to hate somebody to not proselytize? How much do you have to hate somebody to believe that everlasting life is possible and not tell them that?" - Penn Jillette
